

ABORTION CENTER CLOSES AS 40 DAYS FOR LIFE DRAWS TO A CLOSE



A dedicated group of volunteers with 40 Days for Life gathered for prayer outside the abortion clinic in northeast Pensacola November 6, praying in thanksgiving for the closure of the center one week earlier.

The Community Healthcare Center of Pensacola, Inc., a facility that provided abortions, closed Oct. 30 as the 40 Days for Life campaign of prayer and fasting drew to a close.

The center closed due to a failure to pay a \$413,000 fine to the state for a licensing violation.

Volunteers, many of whom had gathered for prayer outside the clinic for years, came together in prayer on Nov. 6 to offer prayers of thanksgiving for the closure.

Dr. Ernie Cyr, who organized the 40 Days for Life campaign with his wife Mary Beth, said to the group, "It is wonderful to see and feel the peace of Christ here on this Friday morning, when on past Fridays many cars would have already been pulling into the center. Thank you for your commitment, for your prayers and fasting, that have brought us to this peaceful morning. May the glory be to God for the closing of this place."
